#### Greece Two churches near Thessaloniki

- Next we visited a Roma village on foot since it is not tour bus accessible. On the way we met a number of Roma who had finished high schools. We thank the Lord for this progress.






 The villagers came to listen to Bible stories given by Rev. Grover Crosby.

#### Veles

- On the mountains of this small town, Roma lived side by side with the Macedonians, quite a few of them are Muslims.
- 7 years ago, a Serbian girl met a Roma from Macedonia. Following God's guidance, together they settled in Macedonia and served the Roma people.
- A brother was willing to rent out his property to be used as a church.

- Pastor Tefik from a nearby town also came to meet us.









